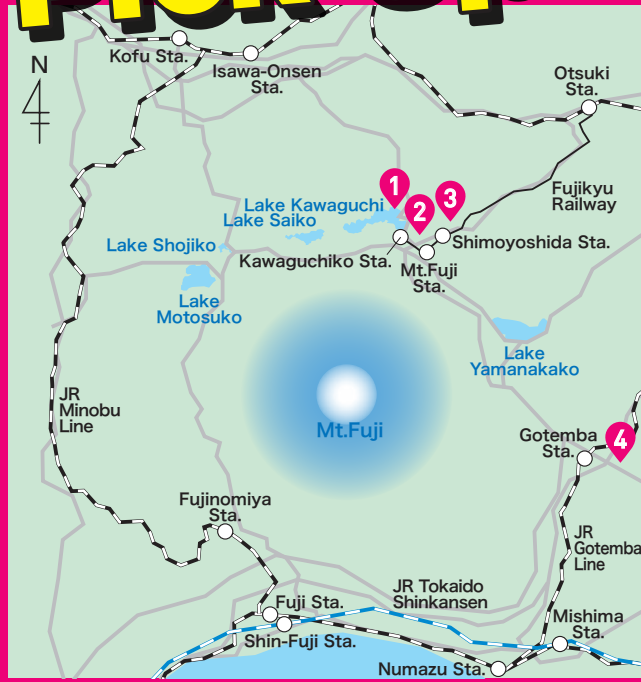
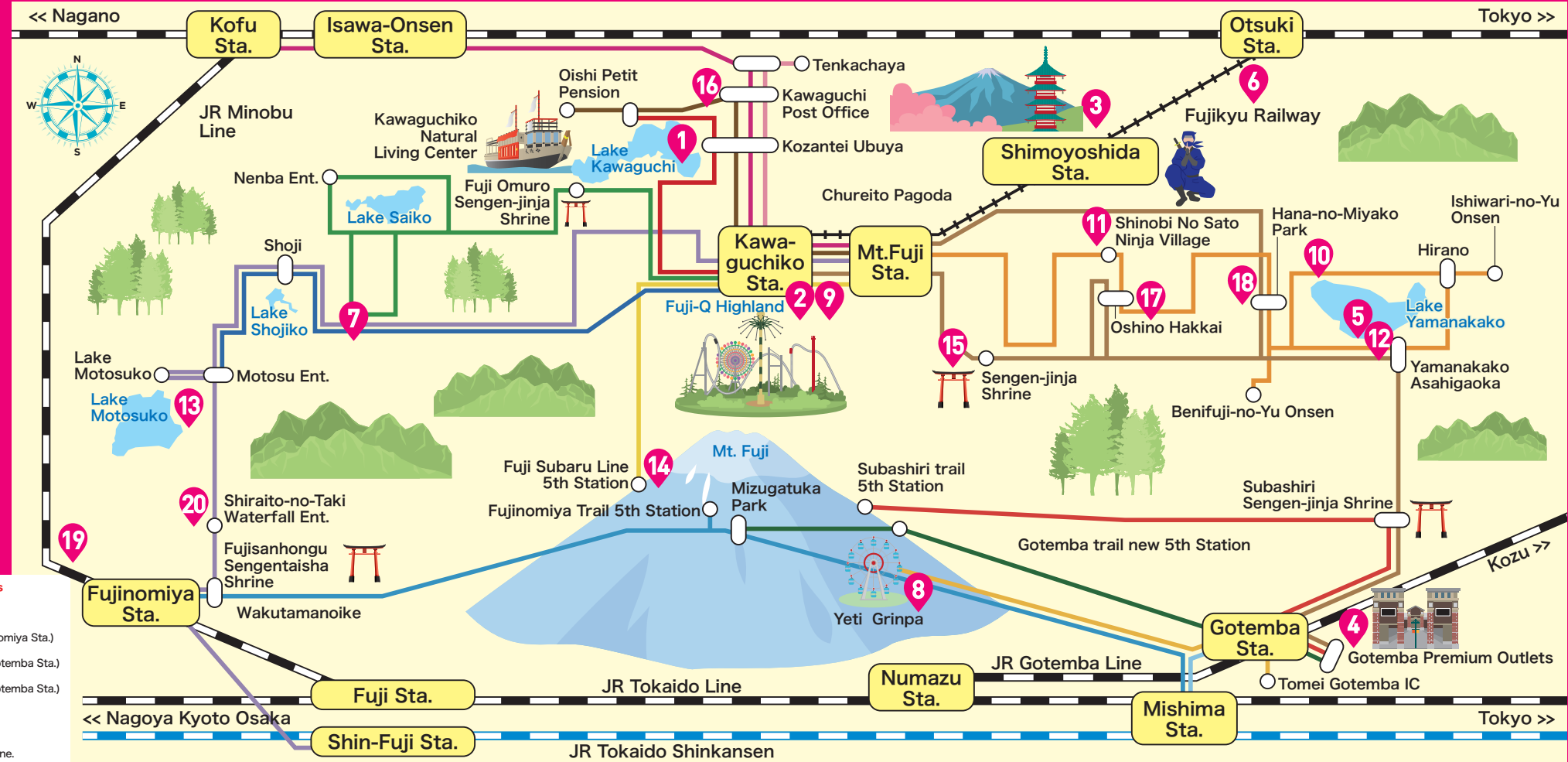

1 Kawaguchiko Appare

From the surface of Lake Kawaguchi, one of the Fuji Five Lakes, you can enjoy the majestic view of Mount Fuji and a 360° panoramic view.

3 Arakurayama Sengen Shrine

Representative photo spot of Japanese scenery. In spring, you can enjoy the stunning views of "spring," the "five-story pagoda," and "Mount Fuji."

5 Yamanakako Swan Lake

Scenic boat ride featuring beautiful swans swimming on the surface of Lake Yamanaka. People of all ages can enjoy it.

6 Fujikyu Railway

Cable car offering breathtaking views of Mount Fuji and Lake Kawaguchi. From the summit, you can gaze out over the majestic base of Mount Fuji.

7 Fugaku Wind Cave Narusawa Ice Cave

Caves formed by Mount Fuji's lava, where you can also experience a sense of adventure.

8 Grinpa Snow-Park Yeti

Amusement park and ski resort located at the 2nd station of Mount Fuji.

2 Fuji-Q Highland

Amusement park at the base of Mount Fuji where people of all ages, from young people to families, can enjoy some of the "largest in the world" entertainment.

4 GOTEMBA PREMIUM OUTLETS

It's a premier shopping resort in Japan, located on a vast site with a view of Mount Fuji, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and boasting the largest area of any shopping resort in the country.

9 Highland Resort Hotel and Spa

Resort hotel where you can relax in a luxurious space with meticulous attention to detail, all while enjoying the majestic view of Mount Fuji right in front of you.

10 Hotel Mt. Fuji

Hotel designed for viewing Mount Fuji. You can spend a relaxing time right in front of Mount Fuji.

11 Oshino Ninja Village

Ninjas appear in Oshino! You can enjoy ninja experiences and watch actual ninja shows while wearing a ninja uniform.

12 Yamanakako no kaba

Amphibious bus that lets you enjoy the great nature of Mount Fuji and Lake Yamanaka from both land and water. Splash into Lake Yamanaka!

13 Motosuko Resort

Facility where you can enjoy seasonal flowers, such as the Shibazakura Festival in spring and the Rainbow Flower Festival in autumn.

14 Mt. Fuji 5th Station

Rest house located at the 5th station of Mount Fuji. You can enjoy the atmosphere of climbing Mount Fuji and the sea of clouds from the mountain.

15 Kitaguchi-Hongu Fuji Sengen Shrine

Shrine representing the Mount Fuji and Fuji Five Lakes area. Surrounded by tall cedar forests, the stone lanterns lining the approach create a majestic atmosphere.

16 Kawaguchi Asama Shrine

The stunning view of Mount Fuji from the torii gate in the sky is an excellent photo spot.

17 Oshino Hakkai

The "Oshino Hakkai," a natural monument, consists of eight spring-fed ponds with their source in the subterranean waters of Mount Fuji.

18 Hana no Miyako Park

Relaxing garden covering 300,000 square meters where you can enjoy the vibrant display of various flowers changing with each season.

19 Mt. Fuji World Heritage Center

Facility for "protecting, preserving, maintaining, and ensuring the transmission to future generations" of a World Heritage site, and it also includes academic research functions.

20 Shiraito Fall

The snowmelt from Mount Fuji emerges from the sheer cliff at the boundary between the permeable upper layer of the Shin-Fuji volcanic strata and the impermeable lower layer of the Ko-Fuji volcanic strata.
